

BREXIT

What happens after 31 January 2020 if you are a UK-national (or family member of) who lives/works/studies in the Netherlands? >>>>>

I have **no** EU permanent residence permit document on 31 January 2020.

There will be a transition period until 31 December 2020. During this transition period you do not need a document. After the transition period you do need a document.

During the transition period you will receive an invitation letter from IND to apply online for a residence permit document. The application must be done within 28 days from receipt of the invitation. The longer you have been registered at your address, the sooner you will receive the invitation.

You will need to pay a fee: adults € 58 / minors € 31.



I have an EU permanent residence permit document on 31 January 2020

There will be a transition period until 31 December 2020. During this transition period you do not need a new document. After the transition period you need a Dutch permanent permit.

You do not need to take action until IND notifies you to apply for the permit. This will happen after 31 December 2020.

The replacement of your permit for a Dutch permanent residence document will be free of charge.
